Q.1 What is Mental Maths Competition ?

- A.** The idea of Mental Maths Competition (MMC) had originated in Singapore by **Mr. Divesh R. Shah**, founder of Math Vision Pte. Ltd. Mr. Divesh R. Shah, himself is one of the world renowned Mental Maths Calculator. GMSE is conducting MMC in association with Math Vision Pte. Ltd. Q.2 How can a student benefit from Mental Maths Competition?

- A.** Better calculation skills help to improve one's intelligence level and thus gives a boost to one's confidence. Unfortunately the normal course studies does not enhance such basic skills. We focus more and more on complicated formulae and their application, leaving out important things like basic calculations. MMC is an initiative to promote this vital survival skill that is indispensable i.e. calculation. It is an initiative to move out of this normal trend of things and rise up in your performance.

Q.3 What is the difference between Mental Maths Competition and other competitive exams ?

- A.** The basic purpose of the competition is to inculcate affinity towards Maths and remove the fear of examination of Maths. The curriculum is designed in such a way that students with different mathematical aptitudes will find it achievable as well as challenging. MMC will help enable students to achieve speed and accuracy in calculations.

Q.4 What prizes do student get ?

- A.** The Rank 1, Rank 2 and Rank 3 holders will be awarded with Trophies . Winners from Rank 4 to Rank 10 will be given medals as the consolation prize which will be sent by courier to their residence.

Q.5 Do you conduct any other exam ?

- A.** No. GMSE is conducting only Mental Maths Competition as an annual event.

Q.6 Who sets the papers ?

- A.** The skeleton of the paper is modelled by Math Vision Pte. Ltd. Singapore. The difficulty level of question papers is set by Global Maths Science Education R & D department by carefully reviewing the syllabus. The paper is set in such a way that students across all streams will find its stress free and achievable.

Q.7 Who checks the papers ?

- A.** GMSE has a dedicated team of trained teachers for correction of papers. Std. 1 and Std.2 papers are checked manually as per the guidelines set by us. (These papers are moderated further to avoid any errors.) Std.3 to Std.7 papers are checked using OMR correction software.

Q.8 Do the student need any special coaching for the competition ?

A. The format of the competition is very simplified and parent can help their wards to practice for the competition. The key to success in the competition is dedicated and regular practice.

Q.9 What study material is available for practice ?

A. On registration, we provide a mock paper to the student. The mock paper gives you an idea about the syllabus as well as kind of questions asked in the examination. We also upload 4 practice papers on our website on each of the Sundays one month before the examination along with the answer key. For more practice, parents can buy books available at our registration centres.

Q.10 What happens if a student falls sick or has any other exam on the same day ?

A. If you wish to change the selected centre due to sickness or any other exam, a prior request should be made via email 8 days before the selected competition date.

Q.11 What happens if a student remains absent ?

A. If a student remains absent on the selected competition date due to any reason, then the student can attempt the competition at Ghatkopar centre or Grant Road centre only. In the above case, student needs to register once again by paying registration fees of Rs. 400/- at any of our registration centres on or before end of October in cash only.

Q.12 Is the school uniform mandatory on the day of competition ?

A. No. The school uniform is not mandatory for students on the day of competition. Students can wear any formal attire as per their comfort.

Q.13 Do students get any examination seat number ?

A. No. Students are not given any seat number on the day of the competition. Students are made to sit standard-wise and our volunteers help the students occupy their seats. Admission card and School ID card is must at the time of competition.

Q.14 How many rounds are there in the competition?

A. The competition consists of only one round and the winners are decided as per their performance in that single round itself.

Q.15 Can one student appear at two different examination centres on different dates ?

A. No. Student is allowed to attempt only one paper at his/her selected competition venue.

Q.16 Is the question paper same for different dates of the competition ?

A. No. Each date of the competition is assigned a different paper with the same difficulty level for each paper.
